

The 2017 Ohio QSO Party

The fourth Saturday of August once again provided the hams of Ohio their chance to be on the fun end of the pileups, as the sought after guys. While we avoided the thunderstorms that plagued the OhQP in 2016, we weren't able to avoid the fact that we are nearing the bottom of the sunspot cycle. Total QSOs were up 5,000 from 2016, but still down 10,000 from the good old days of 2015. The breakdowns:

All 88 Ohio counties showed up in the logs, though some only barely. Logan county was the rarest, with only three QSOs reported. Pickaway was not far behind (or ahead?) with four QSOs. The next rarest was a shocker – normally easy Lake county, with nine QSOs. At the other end, Cuyahoga with 1140 QSOs was most worked, with Butler's 1055 not far behind. Delaware county, often the most worked, was down in numbers because two of their usual stalwarts, K8MP and W8KTQ, headed off to rare Vinton county as K8V for an excellent multiop expedition. Georgia was the most worked state, with Michigan, Pennsylvania, and New York following up, each with over 1000 QSOs in the Ohio logs.

One new category record was set this year: Tim Mitchell, K9TM, blew away the old Ohio Single Operator QRP record, and of course earned the corresponding plaque. There were other familiar faces taking home plaques: Ohio SOHP KW8N; Ohio SOLP W8WTS; and Out of State SOHP N4PN. One time Buckeye AD8J, operating his remote station from near Ashville, NC, took the Out State LP honors, with state QSO party aficionado WN4AFP in South Carolina repeating his 2016 top score. K8T, operated by WA3C and W3NO from WA3C's Jefferson county QTH took the multioperator award, and K8O, operated by K8NZ and W8CAR, were the top Ohio mobile. K8RYU, from Marietta, once again did his usual much appreciated service of taking his Rover operation to some of Ohio's rarest and most remote counties in the southeastern part of the state, and earned the Rover plaque in doing so. Ohio single mode plaque winners were K1LT on CW and KC8QDQ on SSB. The Queen City Emergency Net, W8VVL, was the top Emergency Operations Center Station. Rounding out the plaque winners were the geographical categories, with DX entrant OM2VL, who had the #8 overall out of state score, and from the Mountain/Pacific time zone, WA2JQZ earned his wood.

Top club efforts were by the Delaware Amateur Radio Association from Ohio, and the South East Contest Club from out of state.
